## **ORDINANCE 2014-01**

## AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 503, PUBLIC WAYS, SECTION 8, PARKING TO PROHIBIT PARKING OF SEMI TRAILERS, TRUCK TRACTORS CAMPERS AND MOTOR HOMES IN A RESIDENTIAL DISTRICT

The City of Trimont does ordain:

Section 1. Section 5.03, Subd. 8 of the Trimont City Code is amended to read as follows:

It is unlawful for any person as a driver or operator of a semi-trailer, as the registered owner of a semi trailer to park, leave standing, or cause, allow or permit to be parked, stopped, or left standing, or cause, allow, or permit to be parked, stopped, or left standing, whether knowingly, or unknowingly, any such semi-trailer or truck tractor, within any area zoned as a residential district, without first obtaining a permit from the office of the City Clerk, and except for the purpose of and while engaged in the loading or unloading of such semi-trailer. Parking of the aforesaid vehicles shall be unlawful whether on public way, alley or on private property within a residential district.

The City Council shall, by regulation, establish the requirements for issuance of a truck tractor-semi parking permit.

It is unlawful for any person to park, leave standing, or cause, allow or permit to be parked, stopped or left standing, whether knowingly or unknowingly, any camper or motor home in a residential district, except when it is parked or placed or left standing in the side or rear yard of a lot with a residential home.
